MANAGEMENT AND PROTECTION OF NATURE

The senior agricultural technician in management and protection of nature can work in the animation of nature or in the management of natural spaces. In the field, the two trades are rarely separated. This versatile professional thus has a large number of tasks and roles.

He sensitizes the public to nature and the environment, for example by accompanying discovery classes. His naturalistic culture, his knowledge of communication tools allow him to manage and promote nature activities. He can also inventory the natural heritage and propose solutions of planning and management of the spaces, to exercise functions of responsible for the protection of the natural heritage. For this, he relies on his knowledge in agronomy, forestry, aquaculture, hunting, landscape... Its employers are most often the initiative unions, holiday and leisure organizations, territorial governments, natural parks, external departments or development agencies.

- 28 weeks of school education with a student schedule of 30 hours per week
