SERVICES TO PEOPLE AND TERRITORIES

The holder of this diploma carries out his activity in structures of associative type (Home help in rural environment, Federation of Host Establishments and Home Services Organizations, recreation center), public bodies (Communal Center of Social Action), private structures (tourism) or private employers.

This diploma teaches to offers local services to people and territories: services for populations, services for communities and businesses; services that contribute to the attractiveness and cohesion of rural territories (social services, services related to transport, leisure, cultural and sporting activities, tourism).

The student learn how to be versatile, mobile, adaptable, have good interpersonal skills and have communication facilities. He must be able to work with a variety of audiences, sometimes difficult ones, and he must know the strengths and particularities of his territory. He must be able to organize and facilitate meetings with stakeholders, including elected officials in his sector, to develop and monitor projects, and to set up leisure activities for the audiences for which it is responsible.

- Duration of training: 3 years
- 30 weeks of school education with a student schedule of 28 hours per week
- European Qualifications Framework : level 4
- The training includes 22 weeks of internship
